Essential Packing Guide

Preparation can increase safety and reduce stress during a hospital stay.

Medical Documentation

Keep these essential documents in a binder and/or digitally on your phone:

- Complete medication and supplement list
- Allergy information
- Vaccination records
- Medical history including diagnoses and surgeries
- Advanced Directives
- ID and insurance cards (plus copies)
- Provider contact information
- Preferred pharmacy details

Pro tip: Make multiple copies of these documents for family and hospital staff.

Personal Comfort Items

- Contact list for loved ones (designate a primary contact)
- Phone, charger, and earphones
- Reading materials
- Eyeglasses and case
- Hearing aids with extra batteries/charger
- Dentures and adhesive
- Notebook and pens
- Sanitizing supplies (wipes, gel)
- Resealable bag to organize small items
- Comfortable shoes with good grip
- Printed photo of yourself with loved ones
